

Erasmus+ Course for Teachers

CLIL for Primary Teachers

This course introduces Primary Teachers to the principles of Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL), as a way to introduce new languages to primary learners.

COURSE OUTLINE

CLIL for Primary Teachers aims to introduce Primary Teachers to the principles of teaching English in a natural environment where the focus is not on language structure or grammar but on language use in different real-life contexts. This course will show teachers of primary students how to adapt CLIL methodology to their everyday teaching of different subjects. It will focus on practical activities which show how to blend content-driven lessons with language learning.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Overall objectives of the mobility. To provide an overview of the principles of CLIL teaching and your role in it as a teacher. To address the difficulties of implementing CLIL in your given teaching context. To analyse a teaching methodology which will allow you to integrate subject and language learning. To provide guidance on how to select subject material and tasks to work on in your lessons.

Added value of the mobility. The course helps participants to have the confidence to implement the principles of CLIL into their teaching practice, while sharing experiences with fellow primary teachers.

Activities to be carried out. Interactive teaching with input sessions, individual and group work. Workshop sessions in which participants reflect on their own practice, how they can integrate their observations into their teaching and share these with fellow participants. Opportunities to enhance their own language skills. Participants are directed towards online resources to further develop their teaching practice related to their own particular focus. Cultural and heritage trips as part of a chaperoned group.

Expected outcomes and impact. This course provides a professional development opportunity which will help participants to feel more confident about applying CLIL strategies in the primary school classrooms. Through project-based activities and workshops, participants will acquire useful tips and insights and will also benefit from knowledge and skills shared by fellow participants. The opportunity to experience new cultural contexts and network with international colleagues is a further positive outcome.

CULTURAL PROGRAMME

The courses are delivered in Atlantic Language School in Galway on Ireland's 'Wild Atlantic' Coast, and participants will have ample opportunity to learn about the cultural heritage of both Ireland and the local area. The week-long programme includes a full-day cultural tour to a local area of scenic and heritage value, a guided historical walking tour of Galway city, and afternoon social and cultural activities.
