COURSE OUTLINE

The Team Building Skills course is designed to assist Higher Education staff to develop the teamwork skills required to work more effectively and productively in their departments and projects. The course will examine topics such as team development, team roles, group dynamics, and conflict management, and considers the role of teamwork within the culture of Higher Education. Participants will also have the opportunity to share ideas and collaborate with fellow Higher Education staff from around Europe.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Overall objectives of the mobility

- To explore how to develop team building skills in a HE setting.
- To gain practical ideas and tools which can assist participants to create and manage teams effectively.
- To share best practices with fellow HE staff.

Added value of the mobility

The course equips participants to build positive workplace practices - to gain confidence in their ability to work effectively in a team or to build productive teams.

Activities to be carried out

Interactive teaching with input sessions, individual and group work. Exploration of tools and practices to build a team and make it operate successfully. Workshop sessions to analyse and explore situations pertinent to the HE sector. Cultural and heritage trips as part of a chaperoned group.

Expected outcomes and impact

This course provides a professional development opportunity for participants which aims to enhance their ability to work effectively in or build a team in the HE sector. Through inbuilt dissemination activities, participants are invited to share knowledge and skills acquired with their colleagues. The opportunity to share ideas and collaborate with fellow Higher Education staff from around Europe is a further positive outcome.

The courses are delivered in Atlantic Centre of Education in Galway on Ireland's 'Wild Atlantic' Coast, and participants will have ample opportunity to learn about the cultural heritage of both Ireland and the local area. The programme includes a full-day cultural tour to a local area of scenic and heritage value, a guided historical walking tour of Galway city, and afternoon social and cultural activities.
